

### Pupil Premium Impact Statement 2020-2021

<b>Intervention</b>	<b>Impact</b>
Therapy - Drama Therapy and Counselling	Pupils better focused in lessons, impact of lockdown far less severe than anticipated due to ongoing therapy during the lockdown period.
Literacy and Numeracy Interventions	Pupils ability to access the whole curriculum improved. Confidence in Maths grew. No differences between PPG pupils and other pupils in terms of attainment and progress.
Extra Curricular activities - skills for independence, college, interviews	Pupils gaining in confidence in the community, better able to access independent skills resources, better prepared for life after Bensham Manor.
Peripatetic Music lessons	Increased confidence for pupils. Social skills noticeably improved.
Attendance monitoring	EWO has had a significant impact on improving pupil attendance in conjunction with the work done by the Family Support and Transition worker.
Headsprout Intervention	Pupils who were non-readers are now more confident with reading.
Extra Curricular Activities - school visits, Forest school, after school clubs	Pupils learning new skills, developing self and regulating their emotions, having new experiences. Improvement in presentation of behaviours. Development of social skills.
Provision of daily fruit for pupils	Staff reported better concentration levels. Reduced barriers to learning.
